



K1/K2/J PROGRAM REGISTRATION AND RACE ACCOUNT INFORMATION

Welcome to another season of skiing at Silver Star Mountain. As an introduction to new members in the K1 thru J2 programs and as a reminder to returning members, following is a brief outline of what your registration fees cover:

- Dryland (Tracking/Testing/Training) commencing in September;
- National Competitor Card and BC Alpine membership for athlete ;
- Professional coaching for the following:
 - Saturday/Sunday Training (Nov – end of March);
 - Extra Days – Fridays;
 - Okanagan Zone races;
 - Zone Finals ;
 - Xmas Camp;
 - Spring Break Camp;
 - Provincial Races;
 - Speed Camp (K1/K2);
 - K2 Westerns;
 - Other unique race events;

Not included :

- Race registration fees – charged to individual racer;
- Race entry fees & lift tickets – charged to individual racer;
- Summer camps;
- Travel, meals, accommodation for racers – group expenses are distributed proportionately if traveling with coach;
- Van trips out of town races – operational costs billed proportionally to all racers in attendance;
- Riders utilizing van for commute up and down the hill will be charged \$5 per ride up. Van picks up at Polson Park and Butcher Boys. Coach to retain log;
- Coaches expenses and accommodation to be split amongst racers in attendance proportionately;

RACE ACCOUNTS

Any costs that are not included in the registration will be charged to racer accounts. Race accounts will be established at the time of registration with a \$500.00 deposit being made to each racers account. The club will draw on these accounts for race registration and lift tickets as events are attended during the season. The accounts will be updated bi-monthly. All debit balances must be paid in full prior to the next race and the race account must be replenished by the members with another deposit.

For ease of delivery, all race account notices will be forwarded by EMAIL only. The race accounts will be forwarded in common spreadsheet software such as MS Excel.

FAMILY CLUB MEMBERSHIP
