



Refund Policy

The Vernon Ski Club is a non-profit ski club. Coaching is planned and committed to in advance of the ski season and is financed through registration fees and fund raising. Due to the resources that are expended once the season begins, the club is not able to provide full refunds following the start of the season.

Therefore, the policy for partial refunds that has been adopted by the Club (effective Jan 1, 2008) is as follows:

Alpine Program (includes all Race Tigers, K and J Athletes)

The Alpine season begins on the date that dryland training commences (usually mid-September). If an athlete withdraws from the program following this date, a pro-rated portion of the coaching fee will be refunded. BC Alpine fees for the athlete as well as the family membership fees cannot be refunded. BC Alpine fees are paid prior to the start of the season and VSC is unable to recover these costs.

A \$10 administration charge will also be applied to all refunds.

Entry Level Program (including Snow Mites, Race Kids (E1) and Nitros (E2))

The Entry Program season commences on the first session date. If an athlete withdraws from the program, a pro-rated portion of the coaching fee will be refunded. BC Alpine fees, uniform fees for the athlete as well as the family membership fees cannot be refunded. BC Alpine fees are paid prior to the start of the season and VSC is unable to recover these costs.

A \$10 administration charge will also be applied to all refunds.
