

Vernon Ski Club Team Accommodation Policies

These policies apply to team travel and accommodation, when athletes are the direct responsibility of coaches, supervisors and the club. Athletes staying in family accommodation are the direct responsibility of their parents.

Supervision – The following supervision policy applies to all athletes

- 1) Athletes to be at accommodation location no later than sunset, unless approved and supervised by the designated adult
- 2) Athletes to be supervised by the designated adult no later than 8pm

Athlete conduct – Applies to all athletes

- 3) Entry into any (bed) room other than the one designated to the athlete is strictly forbidden
- 4) Abide by the schedule that is provided daily at team meetings
- 5) Follow instructions given by supervisors

Supervisor conduct – Applies to designated adults whether it is a coach or parent

- 6) Be on site and stay on site to supervise athletes at designated time
- 7) One supervisor per gender will be designated within the accommodation
- 8) The Supervisor shall not enter the (bed) room of an athlete unless in a life threatening situation.
- 9) Supervisor's must be able to respond to emergency situations including driving within the law if necessary

Coaches "Duty" – The definition of "on duty" is when athletes are still under the coaches' care, further direction is to be provided or meetings are to be held that day with athletes. When these activities are completed and athletes have been put in their parents or supervisor's care, the coach is "off duty". In the absence of parents or supervisors the coach is not "off duty".

Driving – Applies to all designated drivers responsible for any passengers beyond their personal family

- 10) Those driving vehicles will not drive impaired or fatigued

Groups should not travel by vehicle immediately after a competition or full day training. If this is not feasible, no one should drive for more than four hours immediately after the competition or training.

Driver's to have full command of the vehicle and passengers and will enforce the use of seatbelts and follow vehicle laws.

Consent

- 11) Consent to medical treatment to be provided on supplied form, along with any pertinent medical information

In any event this policy cannot be followed, the club will be informed and parent consent will be obtained.
