

The VSC cabin is open for use by all club members on their regular program days. All cabin users have the responsibility for its maintenance and upkeep. PLEASE BE AWARE the Club *does not* hire cleaning personnel to maintain the building. This is a 100% USER MAINTAINED FACILITY.

We require that all cabin users adhere to the following:

- 1. All individuals who use the cabin are required to clean up after themselves. If you (or your child) spill or drop anything on the floor PLEASE PICK IT UP! ALSO, Please clean the microwave immediately if there has been a spill or an over-flow.
- 2. Any individual that initiates or participates in any type of food fight, "steals" lunches or uses the garbage can for target practice will have his/her cabin privileges revoked. There is ZERO tolerance for this type of activity.
- 3. Athletes participating in a two-day (or greater) program will have preferential use of the ski storage space. All skis and poles must be kept in the basement of the club cabin. Only regularly used equipment should remain at the cabin"extras" should be taken home.
- 4. ALL clothing or other personal items must be taken home nightly. (VSC coaches jackets can remain)
- 5. Personal lunch items (plastic containers, travel mugs, etc) must be cleaned up and removed nightly (we don't have the space to store or clean these items)
- 6. If you leave extra equipment or lunch bags in the cabin during the day, please keep it organized in your own equipment bag. Do not leave equipment or clothing scattered around.
- 7. The back balcony is considered 'off-limits'. Jumping from the balcony will result in having your cabin privileges revoked. Parents, please supervise your children.
- 8. The cabin may be "closed" to general club use on certain weekends during the season. This is usually to accommodate race events when the space is needed as a race office and volunteer centre. Please respect these closures.
- 9. The upper floor of the cabin is designated as a "Parents and Coaches Lounge". Athletes are asked to use the main floor and lower level only.
- 10. All Cabin users are expected to assist with weekly cabin cleanup as per the following: (signup-lists will be posted on the bulletin board).
 - Prior to the start of the Entry Level Season: K1/K2/J athletes are responsible for general cleanup 7 days a week.
 - ~ During the Entry Level (EL) season:
 - EL families are responsible for cleanup on Sundays.
 - K1/K2/J athletes are responsible for cleanup on Weekdays and Saturdays.
 - K1/K2/J athletes are responsible for the wax bench and basement area 7 days a week. Waxing tables should be kept clean and equipment properly stored.

General daily clean-up tasks are as follows: (supplies are available in the main bathroom. Please leave a note on the bulletin board if you notice additional supplies are needed)

- ~ Sweep or vacuum floors (damp-map if necessary)
- ~ Wipe down tables
- Remove garbage if cans are more than 3/4 full (take to transfer stn). (check garbage upstairs as well)
- ~ Remove recycling if full (take to transfer stn)
- ~ Wipe down bathrooms
- ~ Place any items left behind in lost and found box.

The Vernon Ski Club executive reserves the right to restrict access to the cabin if members do not respect this space.
