TeamSnap

The offseason was a busy one in terms of administration for VSC. We transferred our existing website and our registration process over to the TeamSnap platform. Many of you will be familiar with TeamSnap from other activities your family is involved in. It is a great app for managing and participating on teams and will be a great tool for the upcoming season. There have been some growing pains associated with the start up so please be patient with us and reach out for help as needed.

Registration tips:

- When registering you need to create a TeamSnap account or log in to your existing account
- Once logged in you can choose the program you want to register in
- Follow the prompts!
- Payment: You have the option of paying "online" by credit card. This will introduce extra fees by TeamSnap. The other option is to pay "Offline" and send an e-transfer to payvsc@gmail.com
- Once you have registered our VSC tech elves will assign your athlete(s) to a roster and you will receive an email to log in to the TeamSnap app to link the roster to your account. This may take a day or two.
- Once you are added to the roster you can go into the App and see the team schedule and other information

TeamSnap App

The app can be installed on your mobile device and you will have access to the team roster and schedule at all times. Once the season starts coaches will be using the app for communication purposes and you will be asked to confirm attendance for each training and event day.
