

VSC CLUB CABIN POLICY



Background

Vernon Ski Club provides a club cabin for use exclusively by VSC members. The cabin is 100% member maintained and this policy details expectations for its maintenance and use.

Policy

1. The Code of Conduct must be followed at all times while using the Club Cabin.
2. All individuals who use the cabin are required to clean up after themselves. Dropped food or other items must be picked up and the microwave cleaned if there is a spill or splatter.
3. Lunch waste is to be packed out as we do not have the capacity for large amounts of garbage. Lunch containers are to be taken home at the end of the day.
4. There is zero tolerance for food fights or throwing of food.
5. All families must sign up for one club cabin cleaning shift per season, as per the member Volunteer Commitment. Cleaning supplies and instructions will be provided.
6. VSC is not responsible for lost or stolen gear or personal items. Gear stored at the cabin is done at the risk of the owner.
7. Bags left in the cabin during program time must be stowed neatly in the cubbies provided.
8. Ski storage space in the basement is for regularly used items only, and items must be stored neatly in the racks. Items must be labelled with your family name and space is prioritized for athletes in 3+ day programs. Extra items must be taken home. All clothing and personal items must be taken home.
9. The back balcony is off-limits to athletes.
10. The upper floor of the cabin has the designated Parents Lounge and Coaches room, and is for employees and adults only.
11. There is no parking or drop off in front of the cabin for safety reasons.
12. The Club Cabin may be closed during the regular season when VSC is hosting large events.
13. The door code will be provided to members and should not be shared with younger athletes or non-members.
14. The cabin must be properly locked at the end of the day; if there is no one at the cabin assume you are the last one out, secure the building and lock the downstairs and front doors.
15. Cameras record activity outside the cabin and in the common areas inside the cabin to increase safety and security.
16. Members not following the Code of Conduct and/or this policy will have their cabin privileges revoked.
